REALTORS® are required by the National Association of REALTORS® to complete ethics training. This is the all new mandatory Cycle Three (01/01/09 - 12/31/12) Quadrennial Ethics Training and is NOT to be confused with the previous Quadrennial Training taken (01/01/05 - 12/31/08). This class includes all the recent policy changes and additions. New content has been added. You will learn the history of the Code of Ethics and why it is important to you, the difference between an Ethics and Arbitration Complaint, what is Procuring Cause, and important information and case studies to help you stay out of trouble.
